**PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN'S SYMBOL
AND ITS MEANING**



Forgiven and freed by grace through faith, the central figure stands in praise.

Rooted in faith, the trio of women emerges. The outline of the central figure forms a cross. We are Presbyterian women, engrafted in Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. It is no longer we who live, but Christ who lives in us.

The right figure holds a book to guide her reading, studying, praying, or meditating.

The left figure reaches out to care for others, as she shares, nurtures, and heals. The circle represents the church worldwide where women offer their gifts and talents in the midst of the global community.

The uplifted arms of the central figure reach out to embrace a just peace for the world. The relationship between the three figures depicts lives of wholeness rather than turmoil.

The three women have no distinct features and represent all women. The shapes surrounding them express energy, strength, and openness.

Our name, **Presbyterian Women**, ties us to our denomination. The Bible resembles the Bible depicted in the PC (USA) Seal.

Guided by our Purpose, we witness to the reality of God's realm.

STANDING RULES OF PWGL
2019

1. The Yearbook of Presbyterian Women of the Presbytery of Giddings-Lovejoy shall be printed at the discretion and direction of the PWGL Coordinating Team.
2. Distribution of the Yearbook shall be as follows: one copy each to the Moderator of each PWC (Presbyterian Women of the Congregation), the Moderator of each of the PWPs in the Synod, the Moderator(s) of PWSMA, the members of the PWGL Coordinating Team, the contact person at the Presbytery office, and any of the committees or corresponding entities in Louisville need the information.
3. The names, addresses, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses of the leaders of the PWCs shall be sent to the Communicator serving that PWC. The Communicator shall be responsible for contacting all of the PWCs in her cluster and shall send the verified information to the PWGL Secretary or the person responsible for preparing the yearbook.
4. Nominees for PWP CT leaders are expected to be present for their election and installation at the Spring Gathering.
5. Each Coordinating Team member shall pass on to her successor any helpful information of her activities and accomplishments.
6. The Moderator of the Search Committee or a member of her committee shall be in attendance at all of the Gatherings.
7. All Communicators are expected to attend the Coordinator/Leadership training programs each year as offered. Information on the particular churches served by a Communicator should be passed on to her successor.
8. All PWC's who receive PWP communications are requested to contribute to the operating fund of PWGL. Guide lines are outlined on the Treasurer's page in the Yearbook.

ARTICLE VIII. AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be amended at any Annual Gathering by a two-thirds vote of those present and voting, provided notice of the proposed amendments has been submitted, in writing, to PW in the Congregations at least thirty (30) days prior to the Gathering. These Bylaws may also be amended by a three-fourths vote without prior notice. These Bylaws may be suspended by a two-thirds vote of those present and voting provided notice of such suspension has been submitted to the members thirty (30) days prior to the gathering.

ARTICLE IX. QUORUM

The quorum for a gathering of PW in the Presbytery shall represent at least one-fourth of the participating congregations in the Presbytery. The quorum for the Search Committee shall be a majority of its members.

ARTICLE X. PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall govern PW in all cases to which they are applicable and to which they are not inconsistent with these ByLaws and the Constitution of the PC(U.S.A.).

(ByLaws—continued)

Historian—Shall maintain, preserve, and disperse historical records of PW in the Presbytery.

Linkletter Editor—Shall publish news of activities, past and future, of PW of Giddings-Lovejoy, including notice of upcoming gatherings, as requested by the Moderator.

Yearbook Editor—Shall publish a yearbook containing names and addresses of Moderators of each PWC, and such other information as recommended by the CT.

PW Web Link Coordinator(s) - Shall update news of PW on the Presbytery web site.

Section 12. The COORDINATING TEAM shall plan for regular Gatherings and special-interest Gatherings of PW in the Presbytery, identify issues of concern to PW, and provide program support and resources through the Communicators and related staff to PW in the Congregations.

All members of the Coordinating Team shall review and, if necessary, revise their job descriptions on an annual basis and report their findings to the Search Committee and to the Coordinating Team as a whole.

ARTICLE VI. FINANCES

The program of PW in the Presbytery shall be financed through the contributions of PW in the Congregations to the Operating expenses of PW in the Presbytery. The Treasurers of PW in the Congregations shall send the recommended amount annually to the Treasurer of PW in the Presbytery.

ARTICLE VII. GATHERINGS

PW in the Presbytery shall meet at least annually and more often if appropriate. These gatherings shall be open to all women. The election and installation of leaders and approval of the budget shall be done in the context of the Annual Gathering of PW in the Presbytery. All members of PW attending this gathering shall be entitled to vote.

tors to discover what is happening in the churches of the individual clusters and to encourage them to be in contact with their churches on a regular basis. She should compile a summary of the information from the Communicators about their churches and their experiences to be included in the program of the annual Spring Gathering. The Coordinator shall act as interpreter of resource materials and issues of concern to and for PW in the congregations.

Section 9. The COMMUNICATORS shall be members of the Coordinating Team. They shall act, with the leadership of the Communicators Coordinator, as liaisons between the PW in the Congregations of certain clusters of churches and PW in the Presbytery, and shall act to discover leadership potential for the CT. They shall act as consultants to encourage networking in the clusters and to help empower PW to work most effectively.

Section 10. The SEARCH COMMITTEE shall be members of the Coordinating Team. They shall administer the work of the Search Committee and present for election the names of women called to leadership positions to PW in the Presbytery at the Annual Spring Gathering. The Search Committee shall fill Coordinating Team vacancies until the next annual gathering. This may be done by a consensus of the Search Committee with the consent of the Coordinating Team at its next meeting. The MODERATOR OF THE SEARCH COMMITTEE shall be named by the Moderator of the CT from the members of the Search Committee each year, and she shall serve on the Executive Committee.

Section 11. Certain AT-LARGE LEADERS to be named by the Executive Committee shall serve on the Coordinating Team in one-year terms. Additional At-Large Leaders can be named as needed,

Parliamentarian—Shall oversee that meetings are conducted consistent with Robert’s Rules of Order.

Personal Faith Interpreter—Shall provide opportunities for the development of personal faith and encourage use of Horizons magazine, Mission Yearbook of Prayer, and participation in Thank and Birthday Offerings. She shall consult with planners of PW Gatherings to select music in keeping with the theme of the Gathering.

(ByLaws—continued)

Section 4. The VICE MODERATOR FOR JUSTICE AND PEACE shall be a member of the Coordinating Team and the Executive Committee. She shall strive to raise the level of consciousness of the membership by presenting current information relating to justice and peace issues, in keeping with the PW Purpose. In the event the Moderator (and/or Co-Moderator) cannot carry on her duties, the Vice Moderator may be called into service.

Section 5. The SECRETARY shall be a member of the Coordinating Team and the Executive Committee. She shall maintain and preserve working records of PW in the Presbytery. She shall handle any correspondence as directed by the Coordinating Team.

Section 6. The TREASURER shall be a member of the Coordinating Team and the Executive Committee. She shall have knowledge and understanding of the receipts and the disbursements of the operating funds of PW in the Presbytery. She shall receive from PW in the Congregations the Celebration Giving pledges and offerings, and forward these funds to the Central Receiving Service except for the amount pledged for the operating expenses of PW in the Presbytery and PW in the Synod. She shall send to the Treasurer of the PW in the Synod the amount assigned for the operating budget of PW in the Synod. She shall make an annual written financial report to the members of PW in the Presbytery.’

Section 7. The COORDINATOR ON REPRESENTATION shall be a member of the Coordinating Team and the Executive Committee. She shall ensure fair representation from ordained female clergy, commissioned lay pastors, immigrants, old adults and those who are mobility and sight challenged and racial ethnic including African-American, Latin American and Taiwanese.

Section 8. The COMMUNICATORS COORDINATOR shall be a member of the Coordinating Team and the Executive Committee. She shall attend Coordinating Team meetings and shall act as a liaison between the Team and the Communicators. If a Communicator misses a CT meeting, she shall convey pertinent information to the absent Communicator. Several times a year, she shall talk to all of the Communica-

ARTICLE IV. DUTIES OF LEADERS

Section 1. The **MODERATOR** shall be a member of the Coordinating Team and the Executive Committee. She shall preside at all meetings and Gatherings of PW in the Presbytery where business is conducted. She shall be the key person to receive communications on behalf of PW. She shall be the representative to the Coordinating Team of PW in the Synod.

She shall be a voting representative at all Presbytery Gatherings. Should she not be able to attend she may designate a representative from the Coordinating Team. She shall be a voting representative at Churchwide Gatherings. (If there are Co-Moderators instead of one Moderator, the duties of the Moderator shall be divided conveniently.)

Section 2. In the event the Moderator cannot perform in her duties and there is no Co-Moderator, one of the Vice-Moderators shall preside in her absence or at her request. If the office of Moderator becomes vacant and there is no Co-Moderator, one of the Vice-Moderators shall preside until a new Moderator can be elected by the Coordinating Team or at the next regular Annual meeting.

Section 3. The **VICE MODERATOR FOR TOGETHER-IN-SERVICE** shall be a member of the Coordinating Team and the Executive Committee. She shall encourage all PWs in the Congregations to participate in mission and service both on a local level and in the traditional ways of sending mission supplies, including mission dollars, and participation in the Thank Offering and Birthday Offering, all in accordance with the PW Purpose. In the event the Moderator (and/or Co-Moderator) cannot carry on her duties, the Vice Moderator may be called into service.

(ByLaws—continued)

“at large” leaders shall be selected by the Executive Committee. Members of the Coordinating Team of PW in the Presbytery shall be members of the PC(USA).

Section 2. The Executive Committee shall be composed of the Moderator, both Vice Moderators, Secretary, Treasurer, Communicators Coordinator, Coordinator on Representation and Moderator of the Search Committee. A meeting of the Executive Committee can be called at the discretion of the Moderator (either in person or by electronic connection), in order to act on a particular item of business that cannot wait until a regular meeting of the Coordinating Team.

Section 3. The Search Committee shall present nominations for women to be elected to the Coordinating Team at the annual gathering of members of PW in the Presbytery. Additional nominations may be made from the floor but persons making nominations shall have obtained prior consent from the nominee.

Section 4. The Term of office for all elected leaders shall be three years with eligibility for re-election to a second term. Leaders “at large” shall be appointed by the Executive Committee for terms of one year at a time. Suggested “at large” leaders are: Personal Faith Interpreter, Parliamentarian, Historian, Linkletter Editor, Yearbook Editor, PW Web Link Co-Ordinator(s).

Section 5. Rotation system for election to the Coordinating Team shall be established as follows on a three year cycle:

Year 1—2014, 2017, 2020 etc.

Vice Moderator for Justice and Peace
Communicators Coordinator
Communicators for North-Metro Cluster and South Cluster
One Search Committee member

Year 2—2015, 2018, 2021 etc.

Vice Moderator for Together-In-Service
Coordinator on Representation
Secretary
Communicators for West Cluster and Mid-West/South Cluster
One Search Committee member

**BYLAWS FOR PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN IN
GIDDINGS-LOVEJOY**

ARTICLE i. NAME

The name of this organization shall be Presbyterian Women in the Presbytery of Giddings-Lovejoy (PW in the Presbytery).

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

Forgiven and freed by God in Jesus Christ, and empowered by the Holy Spirit, we commit ourselves; to nurture our faith through prayer and Bible study, to support the mission of the church world wide, to work for justice and peace and to buiold an inclusive caring community of women that strengthen the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and witnesses to the promise of God's kingdom.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Members of PW in the Presbytery shall be all women within the Presbytery who choose to participate in, or be supportive of, PW in the Presbytery in any way,.

Section 2. PW intentionally seeks the membership of women from all racial groups so that it may reflect a vision of the whole church as a community of mutual interdependence in which diversity contributes to wholeness.

Section 3. PW in the Presbytery shall be divided into six clusters which are South, West, Mid-Metro, Mid-West/South Metro, North-Metro and East Metro, each cluster led by a "Communicator." The churches included in each cluster shall be determined by the Coordinating Team.

ARTICLE IV. COORDINATING TEAM, EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE

Section 1. The Coordinating Team shall be composed of the Moderator, Vice Moderator for Together-In-Service, Vice Moderator for Justice and Peace, Secretary, Treasurer, Coordinator on Representation, Communicators Coordinator, Communicators, members of the Search Committee, and "at large" leaders with specific responsibilities. When you complete your “**Mission Pledge Form**” in the fall for support of the Church Worldwide (including Presbyterian Women Church-wide), please also consider your pledge to the local operation of PWGL.
