New Commissioned Pastor Class Forming

A Commissioned Pastor is a ruling elder in the Presbytery who is eligible for limited pastoral services. Commissioned Pastors may, for example, moderate the session of a congregation, administer sacraments, and officiate at marriages where permitted by law.

Many current Commissioned Pastors in the presbytery serve as sole pastors of congregations. Others use their training to strengthen leadership roles in their home churches and throughout the presbytery.

Many candidates for the Commissioned Pastor Program complete their training while also employed full-time.

Two-Year Commitment

Attendance at twelve in-person training sessions with local instructors from the Giddings-Lovejoy Presbytery

Typical class size is 8-12 students.
