

In 2022, thousands of advocates for gender justice will gather online for the 66th Commission on the Status of Women. Would you like to join Presbyterian Women's delegation?

The Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) is the principal global intergovernmental body exclusively dedicated to the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women. Each annual session of the Commission focuses on a specific priority theme and a review theme.

The focus of the 66th session of the Commission is achieving gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls in the context of climate change, environmental and disaster risk reduction policies, and programs. The review theme is women's economic empowerment in the changing world of work. Throughout the Commission there

will be opportunities to engage in advocacy efforts, to plan and participate in worship services, to attend and lead educational events, and to share these experiences using social media and other communication tools. Delegates are expected to participate in some manner in all four of these—advocacy, worship, education, and communication while participating in the Commission and the Forum. 

PW Note Cards Now Available for Purchase




